You may take up to an additional 2.0 units of POLS and/ or your second major subject as general electives, if you wish.

You can combine an arts major and a science major. If the primary degree is an art, you must complete at least 12.0 units in arts disciplines. If the primary degree is a science, you must complete at least 12.0 units in science disciplines.

A minimum of 9.0 units of your degree must be at the 2000 level or above. *At least 5.0 units of the 12.0 units required for the combined majors must be at the 3000 level. Each combined major specifies 2.0 units at the 3000 level; therefore, 1.0 unit of electives within the majors must be selected at the 3000 level (1.0 unit from the first major, 1.0 unit from the second major, or 0.5 unit from each.)

Up to half of the requirements for your majors and overall credit requirements may be met via transfer credit, including Letter of Permission (LOP) courses. Courses with a "P" grade are GPA neutral.

Your GPA in your majors must be a 2.0 or above. Your overall GPA must be a 1.7 or above. See the academic calendar for more information.

You are strongly encouraged to seek out academic advising throughout your time at the Mount. However, you are ultimately responsible for meeting all degree requirements as listed in the academic calendar.
